How to Write on Car Windows

Whether it is to make a price visible on that car you have for sale or to let the world know you're a newlywed, writing on car windows is one way to get your message out. Every car has a front and rear window, making plenty of room for a message. The materials used to write on car windows need to be highly visible, be easily removed and be water resistant.

Step 1

Clean the windows you'll be writing on. Plan what you want to say and how it will fit on the window. You want people to focus on your message and not the fact that the letters on one side of the window are much larger and better spaced than on the other side.

Step 2

Using liquid white shoe polish is quick, cheap and easy to see. Wet the applicator on the end of the bottle and write your message on the window. As this product is not made for this purpose, you may need to make more than one pass at writing your sign on the window. Don't try to put on too much at a time because it will drip.

Alternatively, use window markers for colorful signs or to create more interest in your window writing. These markers are easy to find at stores. Wal-Mart and Walgreens both carry these markers, for example. Use is similar to the method used to apply liquid white shoe polish. Simply push down on the bottle to wet the applicator and write.

Tip

To reduce the possibility of dripping letters, apply several lighter layers to build up to the color intensity you desire.

Items you will need:

- Window cleaner
- White liquid shoe polish [**Warning**: You must write carefully because some types of polish can damage the paint on the vehicle.]
- Window markers

Trump Car Flags (smaller size)

As we are familiar, the weather typically gets worse the later into October and into November we get. So as the weather turns worse, doing Trump sign- and flag-waving rallies may not be a practical thing to do. What can we do instead?

Trump Train Road Rallies! But we need to plan for the weather!

Early in the election season, people may choose to use car paint and so other things to push for President Trump, but in rainy weather this will not be possible. It is suggested (and what I'm doing) is buying 10 pro-Trump-related flags which have mini-flag poles which are held in place between the top of your window and the window seal. This way later in the season when I am running Trump Trains and participants show up without flags and cannot do car paint, I have something to loan them. There are many suppliers of such flags including www.ruffinflagwholesale.com, amazon.com, Wallmart.com, etc.

Just a simple and relatively inexpensive way of making sure your Trump Trains are successful, even in soggy weather!

Be Noticed: Tie Cans to Your Car. It's Easy!

Step 1

Get a stick, an old broomstick or piece of skinny scrap wood will do, some string and about 5 empty cans.

Step 2

Cut the stick to about 2.5' or 3' in length.

Step 3

Use a bottle/can opener or similar to punch a hole on the side of the can big enough for the string. Note: Be careful around the cans as the may have sharp edges which can cut!

Step 4

Cut 5 pieces of string about 6' or 7' long, and tie one end to the stick.

Step 5

Tie the other end of the string to one of the cans.

Step 6

Open your car trunk or tailgate, and place the stick with the string tied to it in the trunk or the back of the SUV with the long ends with the cans trailing on the ground behind the vehicle. Note: Make sure none of the strings are interfering with the trunk or tailgate latch.

Set 7

Close the trunk or tailgate and go out and have some fun making some noise with your cans at the Trump Train event!

Step 8

Store your can dragging assembly, and use it for your next Trump Train!
